The EU Water Directives: Efficient tools to reach the ambitious objectives of European joint policy to safeguard water and aquatic environments.

Session description* (180 words, please kindly use media-friendly language)

Through the adoption of the Water Framework Directive (WFD) in October 2000, the European Union (EU) took the pioneering approach of managing water resources based on their natural geographical formations: river basins. Since then, Members States have been implementing the directive and have achieved some significant milestones, such as the production of River Basin Management Plans in 2009, with the goal of achieving good status for the water bodies by 2015.

But the WFD is not all the EU water policy tool. We have to implement jointly a kit of other efficient and specific instruments, such as the Directives on Groundwater, on Environmental Quality Standards (EQS), on Urban Waste Water, on Nitrates, on Floods, on Coasts and Marine Issues, but also the EC Blueprint to safeguard European waters, the Communication on Water Scarcity and Drought, the Policy Paper accompanying the White Paper on Adapting to Climate change on Water...

Although managing rivers at the scale of their basins and setting common objective of good status for all water bodies represent a dramatic progress, it appears now essential to plan integrated implementation of EU Directives which either deal with water resources (WFD, EQS, UWWTD, Nitrates, Floods, Groundwater, etc.) or have an impact

on them (Renewables, Industrial Emissions).

Experience gained and tools developed in EU with implementation of WFD and other directives are of high interest for candidates and neighboring countries but also for many countries in the world.
